ETP SMR - What is it?

The European Technology Platform on Sustainable Mineral Resources (ETP SMR) is an association of entities operating in the Mineral Resources R&I sector across the whole value chain.

Launched in 2005 and received official recognition by the EU-commission in 2008.

Created to secure R&I funding for the raw materials sector and **increase collaboration** within the EU – **building critical mass and reducing fragmentation** within the EU – but also to boost international partnerships



Share of exploration investments (non-ferrous metals) – less than 2 percent to EU Member States




